- Visitors must be logged in the visitors book located in the register
- · Management must inform staff of any such visits
- no visitor will be able to visit / assist a child with any injuries or health concerns.
- no visitor will be allowed to visit any toilets on our sight unless escorted to the correct staff toilet.
